




Located west of Bedford Town, Bromham has an older age profile than the Borough, with 21% of residents aged over 65. A broad mix of non-White British residents form 10% of the population. Bromham's population rose by an estimated 200 between 2001 and 2011.

The majority of households are couples (65%) and 24% are one-person, mainly pensioners. Bromham has extremely high home ownership (89%), with 4% of households renting from social landlords and 7% renting privately. Housing is predominantly detached (52%) and semi-detached (33%), and heated by gas (91%).

Employment as managers, directors and in professional occupations (39%) exceeds the average for all rural parishes. The proportion of residents aged 16+ with degree-level qualifications (37%) is also above the average for all parishes, and only 15% have no qualifications. Health levels are better than the Borough average, despite Bromham's older age profile.

Only 9% of households do not have a car, 41% have 2 cars, and 14% have 3 or more. Most people travel to work by car (78%), 8% work from home, 6% of those in employment commute by train, and 6% also cycle or walk to work.
